After 18 months of running Carolina Courts, and in light of having to relocate due to the Monroe Bypass, we've made the decision to restructure our company to prepare for the future. The changes we are making are both necessary and, at times, difficult.

Matt Jones has been promoted as the General Manager of Carolina Courts and will be responsible for the day to day operations. Matt will be responsible for the oversight of the facility, programs, directors and all other staff at Carolina Courts. Working with Matt will be Rebecca Jones, responsible for administrative support, website management, gym scheduling, front desk oversight & concessions.

Our Volleyball & Basketball Director positions are moving to part time roles. With 90% of our basketball & volleyball programs running in the evenings (outside of summer camps), we felt these positions were more appropriately classified as part time evening roles.

Due to our decision to move the director's roles to part time evening positions, and for personal reasons, Barbie Curry, our current Volleyball Director, will be not be able to stay on board with us. Her last day with Carolina Courts will be 8/12/10. We at Carolina Courts, while deeply saddened by Barbie's decision, completely understand and support her decision 100% to move to the next chapter in her life. Barbie has been instrumental in building a first in class volleyball program here at Carolina Courts and leaves both big shoes to fill and a brand of high quality volleyball instruction behind her. We wish Barbie all the success she desires and thank her from the bottom of our hearts for her years of service to Carolina Courts. Barbie will remain a co-director of our Carolina UVC Club Teams (with Carrie Powell) and may continue to do personal instruction here at Carolina Courts (possibly may help with other programs here too). She is always welcome!

Shelton Collier, Team USA Junior National Coach and Wingate University Coach, will continue to be involved with our volleyball programs and help ensure quality instruction remains a staple at Carolina Courts. We are working with Shelton to find a replacement for Barbie and hope to name someone by the end of July, 2010.

We anticipate NO interruption to our volleyball programs as a result of this change, nor do we anticipate any change in the quality, professionalism and instruction you have known us for. We fully intend to bring energetic, positive and experienced volleyball instruction on a consistent basis for your child(ren).
